Any amounts of money brought by each family member shall be subject to addition. Upon filling out the "Declaration on Bringing and Taking Money in Cash and/or Securities", please introduce it into the customs mail box or hand it to the customs officers upon passing the security area of the International Gateway.

Failure to declare bringing money in cash, in domestic or foreign cheques, money orders or any other securities exceeding 10,000 American Dollars constitutes an infringement to the applicable tax laws and regulations and the imposition of administrative and, in certain cases, criminal penalties such as imprisonment.
